Regular Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Steve Huffman, President

- Steve welcomed visitors, our guests and new members.

Guest Speaker:

- John Larson, Education Director for Owyhee County Historical Society, was unable to be here as our guest speaker. In his place, Bonnie Reiderman read an inspiration piece about Swan Falls and its history. She reminded us that it is a good idea to read about the area we are traveling through when on ATV rides.

General Business:

- A Secretary's Report was not given. March meeting minutes were not available.
- Treasurer's Report was given by Blake Burgess. At the end of March we had a balance of \$3,940 in account. Motion made, seconded, and passed to accept the treasurer's report.
- Membership Report – Mike and Yvette Pierce said that membership and the store looked good. Participation is great. Get your ideas for the store to them.
- Website Report – Pauline Jones talked about the Ride Center on our site. It can be printed, with details for rides. Quinn recently placed "screen print" on the site. Regarding the survey which was handed out at the March meeting, 30% did not fill out the area for "website."

Ticket Drawings:

- The first ticket drawing went to Bill Jones (\$50.) The second drawing (\$50) for membership went to new member, Tami Schafer. A third drawing of \$58 went to Bill Broom.

Past/Future Rides:

- Jim Maxey reported on the recent rides in which he had led or participated, and per the survey, he will slow down.
 - ✓ March 23 – Wilson Creek: 20 riders cleared 86 lbs of tin cans. The money went to charity.
 - ✓ March 30 ride had 25 plus machines. A good ride, led by Rusty.
 - ✓ April 6 – Fossil Butte ride. Jim was tail gunner. Had 18 riders and 15 machines. Only towed back one Polaris. Nine went to Sinker Creek.
 - ✓ April 13 – Jordan Craters. Had ten riders on a brisk day.
- Jim discussed upcoming rides.
 - ✓ April 27th for the Danskin Clean Up led by Rusty Faircloth. It has been two years since the last cleanup. Motorcycle groups will be in on same day.
 - ✓ May 26 and 27th – Hells Canyon Memorial Weekend rides. Always room for one more ATV.
 - ✓ June 27th – Pickle Foot Run. We will camp out.

Old Business:

- Steve reported that the ATV registration changes died in committee. Bill Jones asked that we help him write letters to commissioners. The Department of Transportation wants the funds in their control.
- Steve also spoke of a Disabled Vet Ride. We are looking at late in the season – July, early August. They need to be on machines - spouses and children may be included.
- 41 % participated in the survey.

New Business:

- Bill Jones said that the April 20 is an Intermediate Only ATV ride.
- Bill Jones also said that if you are interested in a Chain Saw Class contact Ray Ingraham at 365-1465. We need ten people. Safety will be pushed in this class.
