

**BOISE ATV TRAIL RIDERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
April 15, 2014**

A meeting of the Boise ATV Trail Riders General Membership was held at Idaho Pizza Company at 405 E. Fairview Ave., Meridian, Idaho, on Tuesday, April 15, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. with Steve Huffman, President, presiding and Blake Burgess acting as Secretary.

Steve Huffman, President, called the meeting to order. The President welcomed and introduced new members and guests.

Steve Huffman introduced Pete of the Boise Ridge Riders. Pete provided an update on the Idaho City area trails and seasonal closures. Pete handed out Motor Vehicle Use Maps for the Idaho City and Mt. Home Ranger Districts, along with a new map of the Thorn Creek area and answered questions from membership regarding the Idaho City area trails.
