

**Boise ATV Trail Riders
Regular Meeting Minutes
February 17, 2015**

A meeting of the Boise ATV Trail Riders General Membership was held at Idaho Pizza Company at 405 E. Fairview Ave., Meridian, Idaho, Tuesday, February 17, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. with Steve Huffman, presiding and Liz Colton acting as Secretary.

Steven Huffman called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM. He welcomed and introduced new members and guests.

Ray Ingram discussed the chainsaw class. If you sign up, you need to be willing to help with the clean-up rides. He will send around a sign-up sheet. The dates for the class are May 2-3 at the Emmett Ranger Station. Get ahold of Ray with any questions. Bill will also be doing a first aid class if anyone is interested. You cannot use the chainsaws at the clean-up without a first aid card. The card is good for 2 years. The clean-up dates are July 15-22.

Dennis Colton, Treasurer, presented the Treasurer's Report for the month of February 2015. In checking, we have \$2,365.11 and in Paypal we have \$35. Bill made a motion to approve the treasurer's report and Mike Pierce 2nd the motion. The motion passes.

Dennis brought the 2015 budget to the floor. The board had to cut the budget by about \$500. We got rid of some line items that were unnecessary. The inventory was completed and everything is accounted for. Pauline mentioned that the web expenses will probably be more than what we have budgeted. The budget may change as the year goes on. Pauline made a motion to accept the budget and Daryl McCracken 2nd the motion. It was passed.

Pauline and Bill have been visiting sponsors and we now have 8 paying sponsors. We get a 10% discount at most of the sponsor's businesses.

Liz Colton, Secretary, said that the minutes were posted on the website. Bill motioned that we accept the minutes and John Schafer 2nd. The motion passed.

Mike and Yvette Pierce, Membership Directors, indicated that the Club has approximately 68 paid memberships to date. The club store has new flashlights, t-shirts and new mugs for sale. There are several shirts can be ordered. New hats will be coming in March or April.

Jim Maxey reviewed past and upcoming rides. There was no agenda with the ride guides handed out tonight. Please check the website for updates. He also discussed why cones are placed at turns on rides. Jim reminded the members to take the Oregon and Idaho safety course so you can go on rides in Oregon. The course is free of charge.

The board decided not to bring up Jim Maxey's proposal on changing the bylaws.

Mike and Yvette Pierce announced 3 ticket drawing and 1 membership drawing throughout the meeting.
