- good boots
- liner socks/wool socks
- toe warmers
- thermals (2 layers)
- flannel lined jeans
- thermal overalls
- wool sweater
- neck gator
- sleeping bag hood
- battery-powered gloves
- good jacket
- helmet
- goggles
- plastic bags (cover shoes)
- cocoon for your ATV

"Fishing and Your ATV"

- one of the best fly fishing areas in the NW is in Idaho.
- Brown trout are found in Owyhee River and the best free stone river in the Middle Fork of the Boise.
- Middle Fork of the Boise from Atlanta to Boise has some of the best fishing. You have to have single baitless hooks and can only fly fish.
- Queen's and Roaring River are also nearby and not a lot of people fish there.
- You can fish year round in the Treasure Valley
- In McCall, best fishing is off Lick Creek Road on the Seasech River. There is great trout fishing.
- Johnson Creek has great cutthroat and trout fishing.
- He showed how to make a fly rod case with 2 inch PVC pipe. a 2 in. cap, and a notch cut out of the top for the reel.
- You need good flies and a good rod to be successful at fly fishing.

Speaker-David Clayborn of Idaho ATV Association

- working on preserving access in Payette Forest Area
- Yellow Pine to Cinebar cannot be accessed anymore
- every club member is part of the state association
- not a lot happening in the legislature right now
- Annual meeting is up north in August (possibly Wallace)
