

**Boise ATV Trail Riders
Regular Meeting Minutes
March 17, 2015**

A meeting of the Boise ATV Trail Riders General Membership was held at Idaho Pizza Company at 405 E. Fairview Ave., Meridian, Idaho, Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. with Steve Huffman, presiding and Liz Colton acting as Secretary.

Steven Huffman called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. He welcomed and introduced new members and guests.

Speakers: Mike and Elizabeth from Air St. Luke's

- They have helicopters in Twin Falls and Boise. They have ground units in many locations across SW Idaho.
- They make 1400 flights a year and 3000 + ground transports a year.
- Having Air St. Luke's pick you up somewhere is very expensive. With an annual membership, you pay nothing out of pocket.
- Membership prices: \$60 PER YEAR for a family pass, \$45 PER YEAR for a group membership. There are reciprocity programs across the NW that accepts Air St. Luke's memberships
- They handed out applications for the membership program. It is \$45 for a year's membership through the club.

Dennis Colton, Treasurer, presented the Treasurer's Report for the month of March 2015. In checking, we have \$3,097.02 and we paid the insurance premium. Linda Colton made a motion to approve the treasurer's report and Mark 2nd the motion. The motion passes.

Liz Colton, Secretary, gave a highlight of last month's minutes. She will get them posted on the website. Daryl motioned that we accept the minutes and Robert 2nd. The motion passed.

Mike and Yvette Pierce, Membership Directors, indicated that the Club has approximately 79 paid memberships to date. They didn't set up the club store tonight because they were running late. They gave away Air St. Luke's shirts and hats as part of the drawings tonight.

Jim Maxey reviewed past and upcoming rides. There was no agenda with the ride guides handed out tonight. Please check the website for updates. Jim reminded the members to take the Oregon and Idaho safety course, so you can go on rides in Oregon. The course is free of charge. He also reminded people that children 17 and under must wear helmets when out on ATV's.

Steve talked about HB129. It has passed the house and is going to the senate. Please contact your senators to tell them to pass this bill.

Steve also talked about the Sinker Creek service project. We will be fixing 5 or 6 crossings so that people cannot cross the creek. New trails will be created instead. The proposed dates are April 23-29 or May 7-13.

The chainsaw class will be May 2-3 in Emmett. You need to have a first aid card in order to use the chainsaws on cleanups. Bill Jones will be teaching a class soon.

Mike and Yvette Pierce announced 3 ticket drawing and 1 membership drawing throughout the meeting.

There was no further business, so the meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:07 p.m.
