

**BOISE ATV TRAIL RIDERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
January 21, 2014**

A meeting of the Boise ATV Trail Riders General Membership was held at Idaho Pizza Company at 405 E. Fairview Ave., Meridian, Idaho, on Tuesday, January 21, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. with Jim Maxey, Director, presiding and Blake Burgess acting as Secretary.

Jim Maxey, Director, called the meeting to order. The Director welcomed and introduced new members and guests.

The Boise ATV Trail Riders 2014 Officers and Directors were introduced as follows: Steve Huffman (absent), President; Doug Davidson, Vice President; Dennis Colton, Treasurer; Blake Burgess, Secretary; Jim Maxey, Director; Mark Messing (absent), Director; and Mike Dahlmeir (absent), Director.

Blake Burgess, Secretary indicated that the minutes of the November 17, 2013 regular meeting were provided as part of the printed meeting agenda. The meeting minutes were unanimously approved as presented.

Dennis Colton, Treasurer, presented the Treasurer's Report for the months of November 30, 2013 and December 31, 2013, indicating an ending cash balance of \$3,737. It was moved and seconded to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Mike and Yvette Pierce, Membership Directors, indicated that 2014 dues must be paid by February 1 in order to maintain access to certain sections of the website, including the ride calendar. Mike also indicated the Club store has several items with Boise ATV logos for sale.

No website report was presented. There was a brief discussion regarding issues with cookies when logging into the website.

Jim Maxey reviewed past and upcoming rides. The upcoming rides, along with the trail difficulty guide, were presented along with the agenda. Jim mentioned the orange cone system utilized last year was a success and will be utilized again in 2014.

Jim Maxey indicated the Emmett, Boise, and Canyon County clubs pledged support to rebuild the trail from Riordan Lake to Meadow Creek Lookout Trail (Yellow Pine area). A grant has been written and submitted to support the trail rebuilding effort.

Linda Colton presented a Christmas Party wrap up. Several members failed to RSVP until the last minute and several showed up without RSVPing. Late RSVPs and no RSVPs present problems ensuring sufficient food is available for all in attendance. Per consensus of members present, Linda will reserve Louie's for the 2014 Club Christmas party.

Mike and Yvette Pierce announced 3 ticket drawings and 1 membership drawing throughout the meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:00 p.m.
