

**BOISE ATV TRAIL RIDERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
July 15, 2014**

A meeting of the Boise ATV Trail Riders General Membership was held at Idaho Pizza Company at 405 E. Fairview Ave., Meridian, Idaho, on Tuesday, July 15, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. with Steve Huffman, President, presiding and Blake Burgess acting as Secretary.

Steve Huffman, President, called the meeting to order. The President welcomed and introduced new members and guests.

Steve Huffman introduced Pam Herrington of Trout Unlimited as the guest speaker. Pam provided an update of a conservation project being investigated for the redband trout in the Sinker Creek/Scotch Bob Creek areas. The group recently completed a similar project in the Grimes/Mores Creek area.
