

**BOISE ATV TRAIL RIDERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
May 20, 2014**

A meeting of the Boise ATV Trail Riders General Membership was held at Idaho Pizza Company at 405 E. Fairview Ave., Meridian, Idaho, on Tuesday, May 20, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. with Steve Huffman, President, presiding and Blake Burgess acting as Secretary.

Steve Huffman, President, called the meeting to order. The President welcomed and introduced new members and guests.

Blake Burgess, Secretary, provided the minutes of the April 15, 2014 regular meeting as part of the printed meeting agenda. The meeting minutes were unanimously approved as presented.

Dennis Colton, Treasurer, presented the Treasurer's Report for the month of April 2014, indicating an ending cash balance of \$3,567 and \$65 in a PayPal account. The cash balance was net of a \$500 insurance premium payment. It was moved and seconded to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion passed unanimously. It was also moved and seconded to approve payment of the annual insurance premium.

Mike and Yvette Pierce, Membership Directors, indicated that the Club has approximately 130 members. Mike indicated the Club store has several new BATR hats, flags and stickers available and other items that can be ordered.

Pauline Jones, web administrator indicated that Quinn Fisher had recently updated the web site, which should clear up a few known issues. Pauline requested members to let her know if any new issues develop.

Jim Maxey reviewed past and upcoming rides. The upcoming rides, along with the trail difficulty guide, were presented along with the agenda.

Steve Huffman indicated Sandra Mitchell of the Idaho Recreation Council was unable to make it to the meeting. Upon further discussion, it was moved and seconded to approve the donation of \$300 to the IRC. The motion passed unanimously.

Steve Huffman updated members on the status of the Becker Integrated Resource Project. The project includes several new trails in the Edna Creek area and the decommissioning of certain existing trails, many of which are dead-end trails. All are encouraged to attend the Forest Service public meeting on May 21.

Doug Davidson reported the collision of 2 UTVs near the Jackpot area that resulted in the death of a driver and severe injuries to others involved. High speed and limited visibility due to dusty conditions contributed to the collision.

Member were reminded of the BATR summer picnic in lieu of the August meeting at Tulley Park. A chainsaw safety class will be announced by Ray Ingram when available.

Mike and Yvette Pierce announced 3 ticket drawings and 1 membership drawing throughout the meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:30 p.m.
