## **Regular Meeting Minutes**

**Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Doug Mason, President**

Doug welcomed our guests and new members.

### **General Business:**

- A Secretary's Report was given by Linda Colton. Motion made to accept, passed. Full minutes are available on the website.
- Treasurer's Report was given by Blake Burgess. Balance as of date, \$2724. Motion made, seconded and passed to accept the treasurer's report.
- Membership Report – Yvette Pierce said that dues should be paid before January 1, 2013. We can pay now, with Pay Pal on the BATVR Website, or with checks at the Christmas Party in December.
- Website Report – Quinn Fisher said that the 2013 rides are being loaded. Need volunteers to help. Need articles written and posted about rides. Members must be paid up to date to view ride calendar.

### **Past/Future Rides:**

- Doug reported that Swan Falls was a great ride. No accidents, but a razor got stuck. Went 30 miles, but back by 2:00 p.m. It was the "dirt ride from Hell."
- Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> ride to Danskin – 8 on the ride, 12 riders on the preride.
- Jim Maxey reported that there were 15 ride leaders from all over the Valley. Planned rides and campouts. Jim thanked Quinn for formatting the ride schedule unto the website.
- Jim said that there is a plan B if the water is too high in the Owyhee River, and warned that the Sheriff and Rangers check registration, insurance and license stickers.
- Haden discussed the State ATV meeting in Twin Falls. 1 razor and 4 ATV's made new trails and Parks and Recreation made some wider. There is in-fighting among the ATV and Dirt Bike Clubs. There are over 400 members in the Twin Falls area.
- Haden reported on the August annual Bayhorse/Challis ride. The view was awesome. There were two different days of new rides. Parks and Rec charged a \$5 fee for lunch, (probably intermediate) ride and the park fee. Had an ice cream social Friday night.

### **Events:**

- The Christmas party will be at Louie's again this year. Cost is \$16 per person. Bring a White Elephant.

**New Business:**

- Haden, as past President is head of the election committee. He, Jim Maxey and Mike Dahlmier presented the following slate of officers:  
Doug Mason, President; Steve Huffman, Vice President; Blake Burgess, Treasurer; Linda Colton, Secretary; and Mark Messing, New Director (3 year position.) There was no opposition. Motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the nominations.

**Political Update:**

- David Claiborne reported that the State ATV meeting was November 2-3 in the Twin Falls area. David is President; Carl Bloomquist is Vice President. Rich Fox and Rusty Fairchild of Mountain Home and Charles Tyson of Canyon County were in attendance. There are 18 clubs in the state and over 2100 members.
- He discussed the Fish and Game Means of Take proposition. It was 2 to 3 votes short in the Senate.
- We need more information about current issues on the website. Need links to other clubs and areas to share GPS tracks. Magic Valley is heading to 600 members.
- There are new legislative issues regarding changes to OHB registration. Parks and Rec is transferring to Idaho Transportation Department which will require private info. Clubs cannot be vendors. Snow Mobiles must be registered.
- Dealers can issue new stickers but not renewals.
