

# Ride Journal - June 17-18, 2005 - Arco State Ride

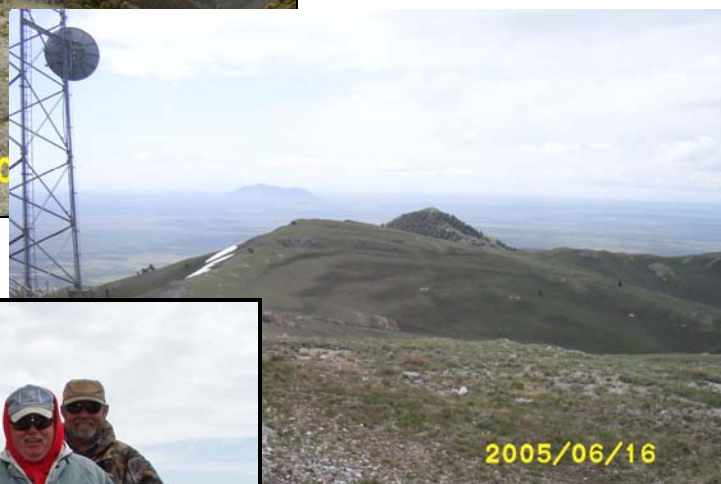
