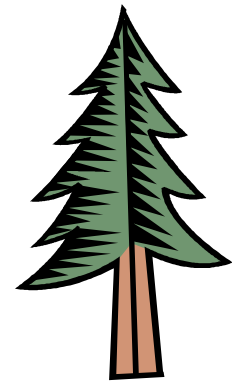
Saturday morning, some more folks came up for the day. We split into two groups. Bill Jones took his crew back on the trail they rode before. Ridge from the south.
