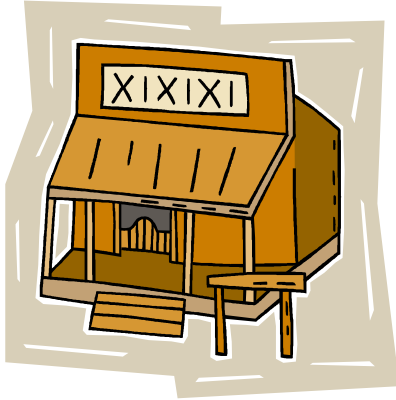


Deadwood Reservoir Ride Journal

Breakfast was at 0700 and we departed at 0800 to the unloading area on highway 17 and the intersection on Scott Mountain road between Garden Valley and Lowman.



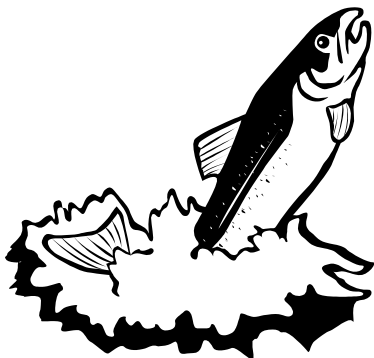
